Web portal enhancement: submit appeals electronically!

We recently completed a system upgrade that allows you to submit appeals via the web portal. Training Webinars are being held monthly. The schedule is located on www.dentaquest.com under "training." In addition, please don't hesitate to contact your provider relations representative if you'd like individual training for your office staff.

Administrative reminders

Claims submission address: Please remember that paper claims should be mailed to our Wisconsin address:

Do not send your claims to the local Austin location, as this will delay processing.

Submitting X-rays: Please keep in mind that claims submitted with more than four un-mounted X-rays will be returned for mounting. The X-rays should be of diagnostic quality, properly mounted, dated, marked with left and right, and identified with the member's name.





DentaQuest

Below are the three X-ray submission options:

- Electronically using National Electronic Attachment or the provider web portal
- Mail duplicate X-rays with your ADA form
- Mail original X-rays, your ADA form and a self-addressed stamped envelope. We are unable to return X-rays received without a SASE. They will be scanned and recycled.
